

# StratDraft - Exporting Drafts

## A Quick Guide

You can now download the complete list of players drafted in your league - the full draft grid - as a .csv file (opens in Excel, Google Sheets, etc.) from three places in the site. The guide below shows how to reach each one and what you get. Note this is different from the older 'Export draft Picks' file, which lists which TEAM owns each pick and is used for importing pick trades - the exports here list the PLAYERS that were actually drafted.

### 1. Draft Grid - the whole draft, any time

How to get there: top menu > Draft Views > Draft Grid.

What you download: a file named DraftGrid<your league number>.csv. It has the teams down the left side and the rounds across the top, with the player each team drafted in every round (and PASS / SKIP / a traded-pick marker where they apply). Use this any time during or after a draft.

### 2. Export an Archived Draft - a past, finished draft

Once a draft has been finalized and archived you can still pull it back out as a .csv. Two ways to get there:

- Top menu > Draft Views > Archived Drafts, then click the [Export CSV] link shown next to a draft in the list; or
- Click the green View icon next to that draft to open it, then click the 'Export to CSV' button at the bottom of the page.

What you download: a file named ArchivedDraft<number>.csv, in the same grid layout as the Draft Grid above - the players drafted, by team and round.

### 3. Export on the Reset Page - grab a copy as you finalize

How to get there: top menu > Admin Tools > Reset Draft (admins only).

What to do: check the new box near the top, 'Download a CSV copy of this draft (blank draft grid format) before resetting,' then submit the reset as usual.

What you download: the same DraftGrid<league number>.csv, opened in a new browser tab BEFORE the reset runs - so you always keep a copy of the completed draft before it is cleared. Wait for that tab to finish downloading, then confirm to continue the reset.

### 4. 'Draft Complete - Finalize It' Reminder (new)

When a draft has finished (every pick made) but has not yet been finalized, admins now see a gold reminder banner on the home page, and the league's admins receive a

one-time email. Finalizing (Admin Tools > Reset Draft) moves the drafted players onto their new teams and saves the completed draft into your archives, where you can re-export it any time using #2 above.

## **About the CSV Format**

All three exports use the same grid layout: a header row, one row per team (with its draft position and name), and one column per round holding the drafted player (or PASS / SKIP / a traded-pick marker). Player names that contain a comma are automatically quoted so spreadsheets read them correctly.
